*Outdoor wood furnaces provide a money-saving benefit to those who can't afford or choose not to pay the ever-increasing price of home heating costs.*

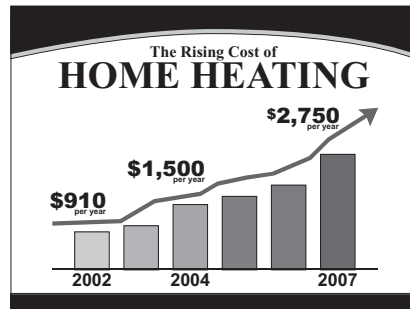

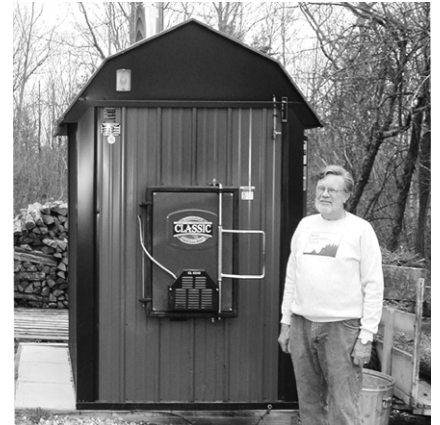

One of the many advantages of heating with an outdoor wood furnace instead of an indoor wood stove is the safety. Barry Smith used to heat his home with three indoor wood stoves until he experienced a chimney fire. His insurance company paid him \$8000 to repair the smoke damage to his home and sent him a policy cancellation notice. After he made the decision to

An outdoor wood furnace is located outside, away from the home, and works with any existing heating system. A water jacket surrounds the furnace firebox and heated water is circulated to the home or building through insulated underground tubes. A heat exchanger or direct circulation conveys the heat into the structure's forced-air furnace, boiler or radiant floor heating system. This allows for normal thermostatic control of temperature for safe, even and comfortable heat. The outdoor furnace has the ability to heat multiple buildings and domestic water.
